



Map of Structures presently on the grounds of Glen Foerd



Next try rearranging the descriptions into the Haiku form.







Spirit of Youth

Follow the numbers to find the outline of the third piece. You fill in the detail and bring the fountain back to life.




The Pond
Three statues once graced the stone pedestals in the pond. Can you avoid the jagged stones and reposition statues in the pond? The statues had to be removed for their safety.












Lil' Ugly

He was put at the top of the steps by the Macalesters in honor of their family dog, a black Newfoundland. He drew the attention of the Foerders to the estate.





 Blue Jay – I am mostly blue but have a white breast.





2. Canada Goose – I look like I am wearing a black hood with a white chinstrap.


Water Tower

Water was pumped from the Poquessing Creek up into the water tower. It then flowed by gravity to provide the estate with water.




Grapes
